### Of Note

Brethren, We are taught not enter upon any great or important undertakings without first invoking the blessing of deity. When completed the Brethren join in unison to say, "**So Mote it Be**". So mote it be can be said to symbolize fellowship. The word mote is an anglo-saxon word, derived from an anomalous verb, motan, and is interpreted to mean "**may or might**" meaning "so may it be," "or so might it be." It is found in the regius poem, the oldest document of the craft.
